4. By entering this competition, you the entrant agree and acknowledge that Business News Pty Ltd is permitted to receive and review your registration data. Entrants agree that personal data including but not limited to, name, phone number and email address may be collected, processed, stored and otherwise used for the purpose of conducting and administering this photographic competition. 5. All entries must be submitted in digital format only using the competition URL as provided on the entry form.
6. The photograph entered must not have been taken prior to 1 January 2018.

  - d. Entries in which you have purchased or secured the rights to use stock photography or images.
